## DRESS CODE

Proper golf attire is required at all times for golfers and non-golfers when visiting the golf course or practice facility. Junior golfers must also conform to all standard dress and etiquette policies. Blue jeans, cut-offs, sweat pants, warm-up suits, tennis shorts or dresses, athletic shorts, bathing attire, collarless or sleeveless shirts (males), tank tops, halter tops, tube tops, mesh shirts and similar attire are NOT appropriate. Shorts or pants that are frayed, show excessive wear or have holes in them are not allowed. Standard t-shirts are not permissible for golfing or practicing. Metal spikes are not permitted on the golf course. Soft-spiked golf shoes or tennis shoes are recommended.

Members are required to inform their guests of the requirements for proper attire prior to arriving at the course. Dressing and undressing is prohibited in the parking lot or in cars. All members and guests are encouraged to use the locker rooms for this purpose as well as the changing of shoes.

## HANDICAP POLICY

In accordance with the United States Golf Association Handicap System, it is the responsibility of every Deerwood Member to post a score for all rounds played. In posting scores, the Equitable Stroke Control must be followed. Deerwood Country Club has adopted the following system for posting scores:

- All Members are expected to check in with the pro shop prior to starting a round.
- Scores are to be posted on the day they are played. Scores should be posted in the golf shop immediately following play via the handicap computer located at the golf shop counter. If, due to time constraints, a Member cannot post a score immediately following a round, a score posted on-line is preferred, provided that score be posted the day the round is completed.
- Scorecards are to be signed and turned in to the Professional Staff after scores have been posted.
- All tournament scores will be posted by the pro shop staff or the tournament committee.
- If a round is played at an away course, scores are to be posted as soon as possible, including USGA Course Rating and Slope Rating.

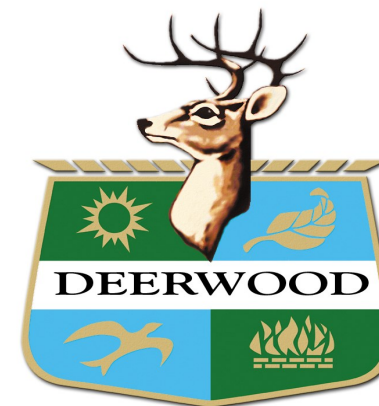

## 2018 POINTS CHALLENGE

Throughout the year, we will conduct an ongoing points challenge for all those who participate. Players gain points based upon participation and how they finish in selected events. A portion of the entry fee will be collected from each event to fund a year-end shootout for the top 20 players to receive golf shop credit. Below is a breakdown of eligible events:

## BUY AT DEERWOOD

Deerwood offers our Members an optional buying program designed to offer significant savings on all golf shop purchases. The annual fee is \$175 and includes all purchases at 12% above wholesale cost including special orders.

## DRIVING RANGE

Deerwood offers our Members an optional practice program that includes unlimited use of the driving range and practice facilities throughout the year for \$20 per month. Members not on the program may use the range on a pay per usage basis and are required to check in the golf shop prior to use.

## LOCKER RENTAL

We offer full and half lockers at the following rates:  
Full lockers: \$132 per year  
Half lockers: \$112 per year

## CLUB STORAGE

We offer club storage at the following rates:  
1 Bag: \$72 per year  
2 Bags: \$132 per year

## CLUB REGRIPPING

We offer club regripping services at a cost of \$2.50 plus the cost of the grip.

## SHOE PROGRAM

We offer shoe shine services including golf, dress and casual shoes on Wednesdays from 2:00-6:00 and Saturdays from 8:00-12:00. A monthly shoe program is available for \$30/mo for an individual and \$45/mo for family.

## Did You Know?

- Tee times may be made ten days in advance.
- Juniors must possess a drivers permit or license to operate a golf cart.
- **All players** must register in the golf shop before play including walkers.
- Walking is permitted anytime Tuesday-Thursday and after 2pm (1pm in winter) Friday-Sunday.
- Playing the golf course is prohibited on Monday's or scheduled days closed.
- You must register your guest in the golf shop when using the practice facilities other than pre-round warm up.
- The Deerwood speed of play policy recommends a foursome to complete their round in <= four hours.
- Members and residents of Deerwood are permitted to walk on the cart paths before and after dusk only.
