JOB DESCRIPTION

REPORTS TO: Fitness Director & Head Lifeguard

JOB SUMMARY: Must be Red Cross Advanced Lifesaving certified; Standard First Aid and CPR for the Professional Rescuer Certification. Directly responsible for the safety of the bathers within the assigned area; Alert to weather conditions and to potential dangers.

RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE, BUT NOT LIMITED TO:

1. Be punctual always and arrive to work on time, consistently.
2. Must be able to work a flexible schedule, to include weekends and holidays.
3. Clothing must be in proper taste, crisp, clean, and in good repair, upon entering the property. Demeanor must be professional and welcoming.
4. Hair must be clean and cut in a becoming style; Management has final approval.
5. Become proficient on all appropriate equipment and safety features. This includes daily inspections all equipment and features to insure they are in proper working order.
6. Perform all opening or closing duties as assigned.
7. Greet members by name whenever possible.
8. Learn known or potentially hazardous areas of the pool.
9. Participate in all in-service lifeguard training under the guidance of the Head Lifeguard.
10. Respond quickly to all emergency situations in the water using proper procedures and techniques.
11. Provide initial emergency care to maintain life support until qualified medical personnel arrives.
12. Perform all established cleaning procedures and help maintain the Aquatics Facility in a clean and healthful condition.
13. Communicate with other workers regarding the need for additional assistance or equipment.
14. Acquaint members with all areas of aquatic safety.
15. Enforce safety standards and Club rules and regulations.
16. Must be willing to work all summer holidays (i.e. Memorial Day, July 4th, and Labor Day).
17. Perform other jobs that will assist in quality member service as assigned by the Fitness Center Director.

TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE:

Must be CPR certified; Must be able to pass the skills test for CPR. Standard First Aid Certification preferred. Knowledge/experience in an assortment of sports and activities. Swimming experience. Swim teams, lifeguarding and swim instruction a plus. Working knowledge of all current aspects of pool safety and rescue to include the use of a buoy during rescue.

PHYSICAL ABILITIES: Must be physically fit to include passing the following requirements:

- Swim 500 yards in the pool in 9 minutes or less;
- Swim 100 yards in the pool in 1.2 minutes or less;

Must be able to see and hear bathers in the assigned area; Must be able to work on feet, moving about at a quick pace for several hours at a time; Must be able to lift, carry, and move a minimum of 45 pounds, to include equipment and furniture.

Applicant must satisfy a criminal background check, drug screen and have a valid Driver License.
